

THE HISTORICAL LAND OF MALACCA 'More than 500 years of history'

Visit St. Peter's Church (1710) – the oldest Christian Church still in use in Malaysia. Drive past the largest 17th century Chinese cemetery outside of China, located at Bukit China or Chinese Hill. Stop at the foothill to view the Sultan's well before driving through the Portuguese Settlement.

Proceed to view the famous gateway. '**Port De Santiago**' and the ruins of **St. Peter's Church** lined by 17th century Dutch tombstones. Next on the list is '**Red Square**' – the salmon pink Dutch administrative buildings which today house the Malacca Museum and government offices. Visit '**Christchurch Clouds**' or the '**Cheng Hoon Teng Temple**' – the only temple where you can find 3 major doctrines of local Chinese belief under the same roof: Taoism, Buddhism, and Confucianism. Take a stroll along the **Jonker Street** which ends by the banks of the Malacca River especially the Harmony Streets where a Muslim's mosque, Buddhist Temple and Hindu Temple located in the same area/street.
