Come to our Desa Murni Homestay in Temerloh, Pahang and you will be able to immerse in the daily activities of the village folks. Specializing in agro-tourism, this homestay program offers visits to rubber farm, elephant sanctuary, deer land and caving at Mount Senyum; hardly to be experience at other places.

Your unique stay!

- Staying with the host family for few days help you to understand more about their custom.
- Visitors will experience village folk way of life.
- Visitors will be doing a lot of local activity that involves around the nature.

What do we offer you?

- Join our Desa Murni Agro Tour where you will be visiting the farms and plantations besides learning how to tap a rubber tree.
- Jungle trekking while visiting Kuala Gandah Elephant Conservation Centre.
- Learn drawing and painting a white cotton cloth using 'canting' method and turned it into a colorful 'batik'.
- Shopping at the longest day market in Malaysia (3km) at Temerloh Sunday Market.
- Learn how to play traditional spinning top.
- Fishing the famous Patin(Catfish) in Pahang at a pond.
- Visit to the Deer Land Park, which also include ostriches, the Malayan sun bear (HelarctosMalayanus), and Indonesian deer (CervusTimorensis).
- Explore the mystical caves in Mount Senyum.

DAY 1 (-/L/D)

- Upon arrived at Desa Murni Homestay, you will be greeted with welcome ceremony and lunch at the assembly hall.
- Proceed to briefing session and introduction to your foster family.
- Free at your own leisure with the host family.
- Dinner with the host family.

DAY 2(B/L/D)

- After breakfast with the foster family, visit the Deer Land Parkat Bukit Renggitwhere you can learn not only about deer, feed and touch the deers, but also other animals such as ostrich, peacock, tuna deer, nilgai deer (India) and wood-duck (Canada).
 - Lunch and then proceed to the Kuala Gandah Elephant Conservation Centre. Visitors will be expose to this Centre's daily activities such as watching them being fed. Some of the visitors will have a great opportunity to ride on an elephant and bath them in the river.
 - Depart back to the homestay.
 - Dinner with all of the host families.
- (Optional:Mock wedding/Cultural performances).

DAY 3(B/L/-)

- Breakfast with the foster family.
- Shopping at the Temerloh Sunday Bazaar; the longest day market in Malaysia where you could try various kinds of fruits and tasty traditional delicacies at a reasonable price.
- Lunch with the foster family before depart back home.

- Accommodation for 2 nights at the foster family's house only.
- Meals as stated in the itinerary only.
- All tours and transfer as stated in the itinerary only.
