Experience local lifestyle at this traditional Malay village in Negeri Sembilan; well known for its (Minangkabau) culture and unique customs. Don't miss the opportunity to learn how to make traditional sugar-making, handicraft weaving or even rubber tapping. Learn how to play indoor games like congkak or learn our traditional dances.

Your unique stay!

- Accommodation in a warm environment of a village with the foster family.
- Visitors will experience the Minangkabau folk's way of life in a surrounded nature.
- Live in their traditional houses consist of upswept roofs reminiscent of buffalo horns.
- Mock a wedding ceremony where the bride's attire consist of an exquisitely embroidered headdress shaped like a buffalo horn while the groom's attire wear a jacket adorned with gold thread embroidery, woven waist cloth and fashioned tanjak also known as headgear.

What do we offer you?

- Learn how to tap a rubber tree and cook traditional delicacy dishes.
- Test your dancing skills by learning the traditional Minangkabau dances.
- Enjoy our famous local songs with the old folks playing own traditional music instruments.
- Learn how to make traditional handicrafts using rattan weaving method.
- Try your skills in drawing and painting using a manual wax-resist dyeing technique on a white cotton cloth and turned it into a colorful 'Batik'.
- Be one of the bridegrooms in a Minang mock wedding ceremony.

DAY 1 (-/-/D)

- Upon arrived at Pelegong Homestay, you will be greeted with welcome ceremony and refreshment at the assembly hall.
- Introduction to your foster family.
- Free at your own leisure with the foster family.
- Dinner with the foster family.
- Learn how to play CakLempong; the famous traditional musical instrument in Negeri Sembilan.
- Enhance your dancing skills by learning the traditional Minangkabau dance.
- Visitors will be shown the 'Marhaban' & 'Hadrah' ceremony at the assembly hall by the locals.
- Enroute to the foster family house.

DAY 2(B/L/D)

- Breakfast with the foster family.
- Enjoy picnic by cascading beautiful waterfalls and flowing streams at JeramTebrau.
- After lunch, there will be a demonstration on how to make handicraft rattan products such as basket and many more using a weaving method.
- Enjoy watching a demonstration how the village folks is preparing the delicious Cake Tastespotting that also known as 'KuihBahulu'. This Malay muffin is usually served with hot drinks during high-tea.
- Try your skills in playing the traditional games.
- Enroute to the foster family house and dinner.
- The highlight of the day will be the Minangkabaumock wedding ceremony, traditional dance performances, and old folk's songs with a band of traditional instruments.

DAY 3(B/L/-)

- Breakfast with the foster family.
- Depart for the village tour. You will be shown a rubber tapping demonstration and a traditional food demonstration by the locals.
- Proceed to the handicraft showroom where you will learn and test your skills in drawing and painting on a white cotton cloth and turned it into a colorful 'Batik'.
- Visiting Guava Fruit Farm where you can taste this juicy fruit.
- Enroute back to the foster family's house and lunch.
- Depart back home.

✔ Package includes:

- Accommodation for 2 nights at the foster family's house only.
- Meals as stated in the itinerary only.
- All tours and transfer as stated in the itinerary only.

- Any flight or other transportation mode including domestic flight to the homestay.
