Apart from the beach, TelukBahang also offers an array of attraction like no other and will certainly grant you an extraordinary tropical experience

- Homestay visitors in TelukBahang will have the chance to explore the Orchid Farm and discover rare, exotic orchids. A truly enchanting for nature lovers!
- Visit to Penang Butterfly Farm, the tropical world's 1st live butterfly farm and insect sanctuary; home to over 4000 Malaysian butterflies.
- You can visit the Tropical Fruit Farm that covers 25 acres of land located on the hilly terrains of TelukBahang. Savor various exotic fruit such as durians and rambutans.
- Trekking along the reserved forest at Penang National Park; a discreet nature reserve which straddles across 1266 hectares of coastal hill mangroves, beaches and rocky shores, abundant treasures wait to be explored by you. In Peninsular Malaysia, it ranks second in size to Taman Negara!
- Go for the many heritage trails within the city such as Padang Kota, Harmony Street and Penang World Heritage on foot or by trishaw and observe age-old cultural practices.

- Proceed to the handicraft showroom where you will learn and test your skills in drawing and painting on a white cotton cloth and turned it into a colorful 'Batik'.
- Playing the traditional games such as gasing, congkak, gunduand getah.
- Tea time/free and easy with the host family. • Dinner with foster family at the picked restaurant.
- (Optional) Cultural performance or shopping at BalikPulau Night Market. Thimarket provides a lot of delightful and tasteful local dishes.

DAY 2(B/L/D)

- Breakfast with the foster family.
- Proceed to Penang City Tour: Padang Kota, Museum, Harmony Street and Penang World Heritage Trail.
- View the beautiful culture of Islam on Islamic Tour: Kapitan Mosque, Acheh Mosque and Songkok traders at King Street.
- Trishaw experience around the UNESCO heritage city.
- Lunch at a local restaurant.
- Check-in at D'Feringhi Hotel.
- Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Shopping at BatuFeringhi Night Market. This market consist more than 1,000 stalls lining the main road in BatuFeringhi.
- Depart back to the hotel.

- Breakfast and check-out D'Feringghi Hotel.
- Transfer to airport/terminal bus.
